Kodokan Judo is defined by the Kodokan Judo Institute in Tokyo, Japan as, "A Martial Art founded in 1882 by Jigoro Kano himself on his reformation and adaptation of several classical jujutsu systems" (from the Kodokan New Japanese-English Dictionary of Judo). Published August 2000 with forward written by Yukimitsu Kano, President of the Kodokan.

It is a *historical fact*, that the **Kodokan Institute** was *re-opened* after the World War II in the "eyes of the allied forces" not as a "*martial arts institute*" (promoting skills for warfare), but instead as a "sports center" (for recreation). Yet to this day, the "*sport blue gi*" is not allowed in the Kodokan Judo Institute.

While the "*sport venue*" of Kodokan Judo has many benefits, the **Kodokan Judo Institute** remains INDEPENDENT and strongly promotes the *Teaching of ALL the Kodokan Judo Waza & Kata*. Kodokan Judo has *always* been more than just a sport...

Traditional Kodokan Judo is simply the practice of Kodokan Judo as described in the text "Kodokan Judo" by Prof. Jigoro Kano, without the "*overwhelming emphasis*" on the *sport* of Judo. Studying the History, Etiquette, Waza and Kata of Kodokan Judo and enjoying them for what they are - "The Knowledge, Skills and a Way of Life" based on Principles taught by its founder, **Prof. Jigoro Kano**.
